For over 1,800 years, the faith moved forward without the benefit of "signs and wonders" -- the miracles had not continued past the middle of the first century and the ministry of the apostles. But, earlier in the twentieth century, the growth of the pentecostal movement changed all of that.

Today, there is a movement that commonly characterizes itself as "power evangelism." They operate with a theology that presents miraculous manifestations as the means by which people will come to the moment of salvation. Is this the approach endorsed by God?
