

Session Eight: Why Can't People Figure It Out? 5-22-03

Some thoughts are so profound that, even after repeated discussion and prolonged exposure, they remain impossible to fully communicate.

The further these principles might be from one's preconceptions, the difficulty of transference is multiplied: before you can own the new position, you have to relinquish the old one.

When the subject under discussion is casual, it is pretty easy to "buy into" a new concept. When the subject is significant, immense amounts of evaluative energy can be expended in the assessment of new beliefs.
