Five Principles

- 1. God's role is that of a "Master." *Luke* 12:42
- 2. Your role is that of a "Manager". *Luke 12:42*
- 3. The parent's role is to make the children independent of their parents and dependent on God.
- 4. Your performance will someday be evaluated. *Luke 12:43*
- 5. Your potential is a promotion to responsibility. *Luke 12:44,48*

Essential Principle

We are "Managers" and not "Owners." God gave us TIME, ENERGY, EFFORT & MONEY on loan. Your performance is going to be affected by whether you understand this or not.

| EX. | APPROACH | OUTCOME |
|-----|---------------------------|-------------------|
| 1 | Informed, Responsible | Promotion |
| 2 | Informed, Self-serving | Demotion |
| 3 | Informed, Irresponsible | Strong Discipline |
| 4 | Uninformed, Irresponsible | Light Discipline |
